Hemerocallis

Diploid Varieties

(36-42" tall) daylilies of great color, flowers approximately 3-5" in width; June or July bloom times; best in full sun

Bonanza- yellow w/red throat

Frans Hals- russet bi-color

Hyperion- clear lemon yellow

Margaret Perry- orange

Pink Damask- salmon

Rocket City- orange, tall

Siloam Button Box- tan w/purple eye

Tetraploid Varieties

(30-36" tall) larger flowers of heavy substance; June or July bloom time; best in full sun

Baltimore Oriole- red, yellow throat

Cherry Cheeks- watermelon red

Chicago Goldstrike- pure gold

Chicago Petticoats- peachy pink

Chicago Weathermaster- light plum

Luxury Lace- mauve pink

Mary Todd- bright yellow

Scarlet Tanager- red, yellow throat

Starling- deep maroon red

White Comet- white

Repeat Blooming Varieties

Shorter than diploids and tetraploids, these smaller daylilies flower in repeating cycles throughout summer

Black Eyed Stella- yellow, purple throat

Happy Returns- bright yellow

Little Business- dusky rose, green throat

Little Grapette- purple, short

Pardon Me- cranberry red, ruffled

Eenie Weenie- yellow, green throat

Mini Stella- bright yellow, dwarf

Purple d' Oro- medium purple, gold throat

Stella d' Oro- deep gold, short
