Yarrow

Space 18-24" apart; round flat-topped corymbs; full sun, long bloom season; useful as dried and cut flowers
Coronation Gold- 30" deep yellow
Moonshine- 24" lemon, silver foliage
Paprika- 30" dark cherry red

Hollyhock

4-6' tall, larger grey-green rounded leaves; wonderful as background plant along fences or buildings; single or double flowers of various hues; needs full sun

10-12" tall, spreading to 24"; grey-green rounded leaves, beautiful foliage; tiny yellow flowers late spring; best in moist areas; part sun

Space 18" apart, sun or part shade; best used in masses; blooms late summer

Columbine

Space 18" apart; mounded foliage with 18-24" tall stems bearing spurred flowers of mixed colors; part shade or sun; great for naturalizing

10-12" tall, space 12"; full sun; abundant spring flowers on delicate stems, grass-like foliage

Silver Mound

8-10" high, space 24"; exceptionally fine and soft silvery foliage; excellent border or accent plant

Goatsbeard

48" tall, space 36"; cream white plumes blooming approx. 8 weeks; loves part shade and moist soils; very attractive lacy foliage, dark green and lustrous

18-24" tall, space 15-18"; fragrant orange or white flowers mid to late summer, drought tolerant, full sun; food source for the Monarch Butterfly and others

A multitude of blooms late summer into fall; terrific when planted en masse; use in full sun

Space 18" apart; feathery plumes, fine foliage; best in partial shade; long bloom season; prefers moist, humus soils

Brunnera macrophylla

Brunnera

Also called Siberian Bugloss; 12-15" clump forming; large heart-shaped leaves are textured, excellent foliage; small, pretty flowers appear as drifts of blue in late spring; light shade preferred

Variegated Brunnera

Clump forming with large heart-shaped leaves of outstanding white and green; some plants revert to green foliage when new growth appears

10-12" high mounded plants, space 18" apart; abundant blooms all season; full sun to part shade; rock garden or border plant

Bellflowers

20" tall, space 15-18"; strong, thin stems support rounded clusters of star-shaped flowers at the stem tips; varieties subject to availability; full sun

Trumpet Vine

Climbs to 30', space 4' apart; full sun; flower clusters July to September; fast growth

18-24" high; dainty 2-3" cornflower blue blooms held on stems above flat foliage; long season blooms July-Sept.; full sun; good cutting garden plant

30" high; vivid feathery blue flowers for 6 weeks in summer; some rebloom in early fall; full sun, soil adaptable; good cutting plant for flower arrangements

Snow-In-Summer

3-6", low spreader for border or rock gardens; drought tolerant; full sun; dainty white flowers late spring, silvery grey foliage

Turtlehead

24-36" tall, space 18" apart; terminal spikes of unusual flowers; deep green foliage; use in full sun or part shade with moist soil; available in pink and white #1

Cimicifuga racemosa

Bugbane

Narrow spikes of fragrant white flowers on a bushy plant; shady location, prefers moist soils; blooms Aug.-Sept
V. cordifolia-green foliage to 5' tall
Atropurpurea-reddish foliage 4-5' #1

Clematis

Height varies; full sun; roots need to be mulched to stay cool; outstanding large blooms and long flowering season; space 24" apart

18-24" tall; space 18"; full sun; double yellow blooms all season #1

Coreopsis

18" tall, space 18"; delicate pink flowers on ferny foliage; long bloom season #1

Moonbeam Coreopsis

12-15" tall, space 18" apart; soft buttery yellow blooms summer til frost; dark green ferny foliage #1

Coreopsis verticillata

Zagreb Coreopsis

Compact, only 12" tall; single bright golden blooms all summer on dark green foliage #1

Delphinium hybrids

Delphinium

Tall and stately for the back of the border (42"+); space 18" apart; large upright floral spikes in June usually repeating in September; colors rang from whites, blue and purples; very showy; use in full sun; fertilize frequently

Dianthus

Also called Maiden Pinks; 6-12" high, clumpy grass-like foliage; thin stems hold flowers approx. 1" in diameter; great for edging or front of border; long bloom season

Bleeding Heart

Fern-like foliage is bluish green; use in part shade; flowers late spring thru early summer

Digitalis purpurea

Foxglove

3-4' tall, space 24" apart; full sun to light shade; florets of solid colors with spotted markings inside; mixed colors range from cream to deep rose; blooms June-July; reseeds, biennial #1

Echinacea purpurea

Magnus Coneflower

30-36" tall, space 24"; long-blooming perennial with deep rosy pink daisy-like petals around a dark spiky cone center; vigorous and adaptable; full sun #1

Pixie Meadowbrite

Coneflower

Dwarf variety, only 18-20" tall; magenta-pink petals with large amber cones; long bloom time #1

Echinacea

Ruby Star Coneflower

36-40"; Improved purple coneflower; large flower and intense carmine-red color; blooms all summer #1

White Lustre

Coneflower

30-36" tall, space 24"; long blooming perennial with pure white daisy-like petals around a dark spiky cone center; blooms July thru August; full sun #1

Barrenwort

8" high spreading ground-cover type plant that is excellent for dry, shady conditions; flowers April-May; foliage red-tinted turning to green in summer #1

Eupatorium maculatum

Chocolate

Joe Pye Weed

3-4' tall, space 30-36"; foliage dark bronzy purple, enhances other plants by contrast; flowers creamy white #1

Gateway

Joe Pye Weed

4-5' tall; attractive purple stems with toothed foliage; lavender-red flowers have a long bloom season; butterflies and bees love it #1

15-18" tall, space 12-15" apart; use in full sun; yellow petals with broad deep red centers #1

Just as the name implies, small flowers are at the tips of very slender arching stems, moving with every breeze; low mounded foliage, stems to 36"; full sun to part shade; available in pink or white #1

Geraniums

Spreading 24-30", low mounding growth habit and bloom May thru August; prefers full sun to light shade; perennial variety

36" tall, space 24"; large semi-double golden yellow flowers; blooms July-August; good cut flowers, consistent bloomers; full sun #1

Coral Bells

Tiny blooms on thin stems held above low mounding foliage; blooms are secondary to the beautiful leaves of most varieties

3-4' tall, space 30-36" apart and cut back to ground in late fall or every early spring to promote branching; huge 6-8" blooms with prominent stamens; a wonderful showoff in the garden; bloom repeats all summer; call for varieties avail #1

Iberis sempervirens
Candy Tuft

12" high, space 12-15"; low border or rock garden plant with a profusion of white flowers in spring; full sun #1

Iris germanica
German Bearded Iris

Upright foliage approx. 24" tall; strong stems hold large flowers, remarkable showy; blooms May-June, depending on variety; available in variety of colors; use in full sun, do not use much over roots #1

Iris pallida
Zebra Iris

Purple blooms in May are secondary to the foliage which is boldly striped; use in full sun #1

Siberian Iris

24-36" tall, space 24"; very upright slender foliage readily adapts to wet sites; blooms mid to late spring; full sun to part shade

4-8"; silver leaves with a narrow green margin; light pink flowers bloom on & off from spring til fall #1

4-8"; silver leaves with green margins, pure white flowers bloom on & off spring thru fall #1

15-18" compact habit; silvery green foliage with fragrant lavender flowers June-September #1

Shasta Daisy

Pure white petals, yellow centers; long bloom season; use in full sun

Liatris

Also called Gayfeather; 36-48" tall, space 18-24"; forms clumps of fine foliage and tall spikes of tiny, closely set flowers; full sun is best; soil adaptable; available in purple or white #1

Golden Ray

Tall background plants for boggy areas in full sun or for moist shady areas; long stemmed, coarsely toothed foliage is outstanding; flowers on tall stalks July-August
Desdemona-40" yellow flowers, foliage purple-green
Gregynog Gold-60" orange-yellow flowers, green foliage
Przewalskii-60" bright yellow flowers, dark green foliage on black stems #1

Lilium orientalis

Stargazer Lily

Approx. 30" tall; very large, fragrant flowers in July, excellent for cutting; use in groups for the best show in the garden; full sun #1

Liriope spicata

Lilyturf

12" small clumping grass-like plant; spikes of lilac flowers July-August; able to be used as a groundcover; full to part sun #1

Lobelia cardinalis

Cardinal Flower

Beautiful show-off red for partial shade or sun; highly visible 36-42" tall, space 18"; blooms early to late summer; use in moist soil #1

Lupinus polyphyllus

Lupine

24" tall, space 18"; excellent large flower stalks emerging from beautiful palmate leaves; blooms late spring, mixed colors; full sun to light shade and slightly moist acidic soil #1

Mertensia virginica

Virginia Bluebells

24" tall, space 18-24"; clusters of sky blue flowers on arching stems; grayish-green leaves; best in shaded areas where soil is moist; foliage dies back to ground in summer reappearing next spring #1

Monarda didyma

Bee Balm

Many different varieties available; range in heights from 10-48" and colors from pinks, reds, blues and purples; June thru August bloom times; attracts hummingbirds and butterflies #1

Nepeta x faassenii

Catmint

Space 24-30"; sporting tiny trumpet shaped light blue flowers in clusters, July-Sept; full sun; fragrant is pale grey-green; low mounded habit

Oenothera missouriensis

Ozark Sundrops

Long blooming June-Sept; low-growing, sprawling plant that makes good groundcover 10-12" tall; large pale yellow blooms especially showy in evening light; use in full sun #1

Garden Peony

30" tall, space 30-36"; reliable and busy perennial with dark green foliage; large blooms arrive in spring with sweet fragrance; excellent for cutting; best in full sun and organic soil

Tree Peony

42-48" tall, multi-stemmed and woody; producing the most incredible blooms April-May; mixed colors

Papaver orientalis

Oriental Poppy

Foliage 10-12" and sprawling stems to 30"; flowers are spectacular papery thin petals 4-5" across with dark centers; full sun and dry soils; avail in range of colors #1

Parthenocissus quinquefolia

Virginia Creeper

Also called Engelmann Ivy; a robust vine climbing 30-50' to cover almost any surface; beautiful scarlet in fall; one of the first plant to color

Parthenocissus tricuspidata

Boston Ivy

Up to 40' high, space 30" apart; dark green leaves, smaller than those of *P.quinquefolia*, turning excellent reds in fall; sun to part shade

Penstemon digitalis

Husker's Red

Penstemon

30" tall, space 24"; reddish purple stems and foliage very showy; white flowers have a hint of pink on upright panicles; blooms July-Aug.; full sun and dry soil #1

Perovskia atriplicifolia

Russian Sage

4-5' tall, space 30"; wonderful background plant with light blue blooms in summer; foliage grey-green; full sun #1

'Little Spire' Russian Sage

3' x 12-18" with the same characteristics as above #1

Phlox paniculata

Tall Garden Phlox

24-30" tall, space 24-30" apart; tall stems hold large panicles of blooms lasting 6 weeks or more; full sun to light shade

Woodland Phlox

12" tall, space 18"; great as shady area groundcover; low-growing, spreading and semi-evergreen; flowers appear May-June with great fragrance

6-8" high, space 15"; evergreen foliage, covered with blooms in early spring; full sun

30" tall, space 30"; dense bushy habit; very showy, good foliage and masses of blooms; full sun, soil adaptable; available in white or pink #1

Balloon Flower

18-24", slow growing, long-lived plants; pink or blue flowers of distinctive shape, lovely planted in combination of colors; sun to light shade, ordinary soils; blooms June-August

Silver Lace Vine

Grows to 25' high, space 3-4' apart to cover structures; lovely in bloom, delicate white flowers on medium green foliage; great cover for ugly fences; full sun

12-14" tall, space 18-24" apart; flower clusters appear early spring before the decorative foliage; some varieties have different leaf patterns; full shade, moist soil

Rodger's Flower

36-40" tall, space 24" apart; pink flower clusters on plants with superb foliage that is arranged in large fans; very showy, some varieties bronzed; blooms June-July; use in partial shade in moist soil

Black-Eyed Susan

24-30" tall, space 18" apart; fresh yellow flowers with dark button centers; long bloom season; use in full sun; an old favorite

Salvia

Also called Meadow Sage; Showy spikes of blooms appearing in summer and continuing for weeks; use in full sun, drought tolerant

Pincushion Flower

Flat-topped flower heads on slender stems; very attractive to butterflies, blooms early summer into fall; full sun, well drained soil

Autumn Joy Sedum

18" tall, space 24" apart; thick fleshy grey-green foliage erupts with masses of shell pink blooms that turn bronze red; flowers late summer into fall; use in full sun, drought tolerant

Hummelo

Common Betony

10-20" tall, clumps of glossy green foliage with spikes of pink-lavender flowers mid summer; makes good cut flowers; full sun, well-drained soil

Lamb's Ear

Non-invasive; 12-15" high, space 12-15" apart; silvery-green, wooly and thick foliage; standout plant in the planting bed or border; full sun

Stokesia

Stoke's Aster

20" tall, space 18-24"; finely textured flowers with fringed edges and a center of thread-like petals, blooming spring to mid-summer; use in full sun, sandy or well-drained soil

Thymus serpyllum

Mother-of-Thyme

Very low-growing, dense plant with very small leaves of medium green; aromatic, useful as groundcover, essential to herb gardens; tiny red blooms in spring

Spiderwort

Ranging from 15-24" in height, depending on cultivar, space 18" apart; a clumping mass of thick upright stems with long drooping leaves and very pretty 3-petaled flowers that twine around the foliage; available in a variety of colors; full sun & poor soil

Red Fox Veronica

15" high, space 18-24" apart; use in full sun and moist, well-drained soil; free-flowering rosy-red spikes June-August; foliage dark green and narrow; clump forming habit

Veronica

14" x 14", space 18-24" apart; violet blue spike like flowers; very similar to Sunny Border Blue without the mildew problem; moist, well-drained soil

Viola

6-8" tall; heart-shaped glossy green foliage with large purple pansy-like flowers; use in shade, moist soil
